6" knitted mitered square

Needle size: 4"

Worsted weight yarn: 1.5-2 oz each color

Gauge: 6 rows (knit each row) = 1 inch

K2 tog- knit 2 stitches together

PM- place marker

SSK-slip, slip, knit

CO 72 stitches with color A

Starting row- (WS) knit

Row #	Instructions	Stitches left on the needle
1 (color A)	K 34 stitches, SSK PM, K2 tog, K34	2 stitches are decreased (1 stitch on each side of the marker)
2	Knit all stitches	70stitches
3	K 32, SSK, PM, K2tog, K32	
4	Knit all stitches	68 Stitches
5	K30, SSK, PM, K2tog, K30	
6	Knit all stitches	66 stitches
7 (color B)	K stitches, SSK PM, K2 tog, K	

Continue this pattern until you have 4 stitches left if you continue changing color after every 6 rows

OR you will have 2 stitches left if you continue changing color every 8 rows.

I changed color every 6 rows and I had 4 stitches left

When you have 2 stitches left, k2tog and cut yarn and pull through the last loop

When you have 4 stitches left, k, k2tog, k

You have 2 stitches now, k2tog and cut yarn and pull through loop
